Seizure Statistics for Intellectual Property Rights

(01/16/2007) **Comparison of Yearly Domestic Value of IPR Seizures (FY 2002-FY 2006)**

FY 2006 was a record year for the number of IPR seizures and domestic value of goods seized. The domestic value of products seized for IPR violations increased by 67% compared to FY 2005. Generally, domestic value is the cost of the seized goods, plus the costs of shipping and importing the goods into the U.S., and an amount for profit.
